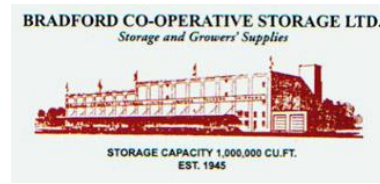

Ontario Crops Research Centre – Bradford (Muck Station) IPM Report 2021

This is the Muck Crops IPM Update for 5 May 2021

Highlights

- Onion transplanting and seeding has begun, but it has slowed down over the past few days because of the rain.
- The scouts have started training for the 2021 season.

Onion Update

A number of onion fields have been seeded and planted throughout the marsh. Seeding is expected to pick up soon as fields start to dry up. Regular scouting will begin in a couple weeks, after onions have gone in.

Carrot Update

Very few carrots have been seeded so far. Carrot weevil traps will be going out in some fields this week. Carrot weevil pressure is often higher in early seeded carrots compared to late seeded carrots.
